After lunch, immerse yourself in the world of Provence's finest rosé wines with visits to two renowned Crus Classés estates: Château Sainte Roseline and Château Roubine. Discover the vineyards and cellars while enjoying guided tastings in the sun-drenched landscapes of the Var region.

## DAY 5 – SATURDAY, 4 SEPTEMBER

---



### *Medieval Les Arcs & Thoronet Abbey*

Depart for Les Arcs-sur-Argens, a charming medieval village dominated by its Saracen tower and winding cobbled streets. Enjoy a stroll through Le Parage, the historic quarter, with its stone façades, vaulted passageways and authentic Provençal character.

Continue to Thoronet Abbey, a masterpiece of 12th-century Cistercian architecture, renowned for the purity of its design, its Romanesque cloister and its timeless atmosphere.

Enjoy a Provençal lunch en route before travelling through landscapes of olive groves and fragrant garrigue towards Salon-de-Provence.

Check-in at Abbaye Sainte-Croix 4★, a former abbey perched on the hills above the region, offering panoramic views of the Alpilles, shaded terraces and a peaceful atmosphere in the heart of Provence.

## DAY 6 – SUNDAY, 5 SEPTEMBER

---

### *Pont Royal Golf & Aix-en-Provence*

Tee-time at Pont Royal Golf Club, a masterpiece and the only golf course in France designed by Severiano Ballesteros. Elevated tee boxes, rolling fairways, subtly protected greens and sweeping views over the Provençal countryside make this one of the golfing highlights of the journey.

While golfers enjoy their round, accompanying guests will discover the charms of Salon-de-Provence, including its Provençal market, historic old town, Château de l'Empéri and local artisan workshops.

Lunch at the clubhouse or nearby, followed by a visit to Aix-en-Provence. Enjoy a free afternoon strolling along the elegant Cours Mirabeau, discovering its fountains, boutiques and inviting café terraces.

## DAY 7 – MONDAY, 6 SEPTEMBER

### *Servanes Golf & Carrières de Lumières*

Tee-time at Servanes Golf Club, a magnificent course set at the foot of the white limestone cliffs of the Alpilles. Surrounded by olive groves, cypress trees and dramatic rock formations, the course offers a unique atmosphere that is both elegant and distinctly Provençal.

While golfers enjoy their round, accompanying guests will discover Saint-Rémy-de-Provence or Maussane-les-Alpilles, with time to wander through charming streets, browse local boutiques, visit an olive oil mill or explore a traditional Provençal market, depending on the day.

Lunch in the Alpilles region followed by an unforgettable visit to the Carrières de Lumières, a spectacular immersive art experience projected onto the monumental walls of former stone quarries.

Free time in the hilltop village of Les Baux-de-Provence before continuing to Avignon.

## DAY 8 – TUESDAY, 7 SEPTEMBER

### *Avignon & Rhône Valley Wines*

A morning dedicated to Avignon, the City of Popes and one of the Rhône Valley's greatest cultural treasures. Discover the Palais des Papes, a UNESCO-listed Gothic masterpiece, followed by a stroll across the famous Pont Saint-Bénézet and through the charming streets of the historic centre.

Lunch in Avignon before heading to the vineyards of Tavel and Lirac, two renowned appellations of the Southern Rhône Valley, celebrated for their characterful rosés and rich, sun-filled red wines.

Enjoy tastings at carefully selected estates chosen by Terra Golfia, where rolling vineyards, stony terroirs and generations of winemaking expertise come together to create exceptional wines.

## DAY 9 – WEDNESDAY, 8 SEPTEMBER

---



### *Grand Avignon Golf & Châteauneuf-du-Pape*

Tee-time at Grand Avignon Golf Club, an elegant and enjoyable course featuring tree-lined fairways, water features and views towards Mont Ventoux. A welcoming and well-balanced 18-hole layout set in the heart of the Rhône Valley region of Provence.

While golfers enjoy their round, accompanying guests will have free time in Avignon to explore the historic centre, browse boutiques and museums, discover the covered market halls or relax in gardens overlooking the Rhône River.

Lunch followed by an afternoon dedicated to Châteauneuf-du-Pape, one of the most prestigious wine appellations in the Southern Rhône Valley. Visit Maison Brotte and its wine museum before enjoying a tasting at Clos du Calvaire or a similar estate, subject to availability.

## DAY 10 – THURSDAY, 9 SEPTEMBER

### *Pont du Gard & Uzès*

## DAY 11 – FRIDAY, 10 SEPTEMBER

### *Nîmes Vacquerolles Golf & the Camargue*

Tee-time at Nîmes Vacquerolles Golf Club, an elegant and technical course nestled in the heart of the Mediterranean garrigue. Surrounded by pine trees, gentle hills and well-protected greens, this course offers a true golfing immersion into the spirit of Southern France.

While golfers enjoy their round, accompanying guests will discover Nîmes, including the magnificent Roman Arena, the Maison Carrée and the charming streets of the historic city centre.

Lunch followed by a visit to Aigues-Mortes and its famous salt marshes. Aboard the panoramic train, discover the pink lagoons, towering salt mountains and the iconic landscapes of the Camargue region.

Return to Massane in the late afternoon.

## DAY 12 – SATURDAY, 11 SEPTEMBER

---

### *Massane Golf & Pic Saint-Loup*

Tee-time at Massane Golf Club, a modern and enjoyable course featuring generous fairways, signature water hazards and undulating greens. A final golfing highlight set within a Mediterranean landscape of olive trees, pine forests and the warm light of the Languedoc.

While golfers are on the course, accompanying guests will explore Montpellier, including the historic Écusson district, charming alleyways, elegant squares, boutiques and lively cafés.

Lunch followed by a journey to the Pic Saint-Loup wine region, one of the most renowned terroirs of the Languedoc, dominated by dramatic limestone cliffs. Visit Domaine de l'Hortus and enjoy a guided tasting of its distinctive red wines and mineral-driven white wines.

### *Thau Lagoon & Mediterranean Flavours*

A signature day celebrating lagoons, oysters and the Mediterranean way of life.

Depart for Marseillan and enjoy a private cruise on the Thau Lagoon. Discover the famous oyster farms, unique lagoon landscapes and savour freshly harvested oysters on board, accompanied by a glass of local white wine.

Lunch inspired by the flavours of the sea, followed by a visit to Maison Noilly Prat, the historic home of France's most famous vermouth and an institution of Marseillan. Enjoy the "Discover Tour", aromatic herb gardens and a guided tasting experience.

Depending on timing, a stop in Sète, often referred to as the "Venice of the Languedoc", offers the opportunity for a stroll along the canals and waterfront with panoramic views over the Mediterranean.

# ESSENTIAL TRAVEL INFORMATIONS



## **Documents & Visas**

Passport valid for at least 3 months after the return date. A Schengen visa is required for South African passport holders and should be applied for at least 3 to 4 weeks prior to departure. Comprehensive travel insurance is strongly recommended, including medical cover, baggage and trip interruption.

## **Health & Comfort**

Stay hydrated and bring sunscreen, a cap or sun hat. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended for village visits and historical sites. Personal medication and a basic travel first-aid kit are advisable.

## **Luggage & Golf Equipment**

1 suitcase and 1 carry-on bag per traveller, plus 1 golf bag per golfer. A labelled golf travel cover is recommended. Luggage should be suitable for private group transportation.

## **Golf Attire & Course Etiquette**

Golf dress code applies: no jeans and no collarless T-shirts. Golf carts or trolleys are subject to the policies of each club and weather conditions.

## **Money, Taxes & Gratuities**

230V electricity supply. European type F/L power sockets. A universal travel adapter is recommended for South African travellers. Wi-Fi is available at all hotels. eSIM or international roaming packages are recommended.

## **Connectivity & Electricity**

230 V, prises européennes type F/L. Adaptateur universel recommandé pour les voyageurs sud-africains. Wi-Fi disponible dans les hôtels. eSIM ou roaming conseillé.

## **Accessibility & Pace**

A fully escorted journey with a balanced pace combining golf, villages, wine tastings, gastronomy and leisure time. Any special requirements, mobility concerns or dietary restrictions should be advised before booking.
