Day 1 – Saturday 12 June

Arrival in Milan & Lake Maggiore

Terra Golfia airport welcome at Milan Malpensa, then head to Lake Maggiore, the most aristocratic of Italy's lakes: the Borromean archipelago (Isola Bella, Isola dei Pescatori), Belle Époque shores, and lush gardens of camellias and azaleas under a mild microclimate, with mountains as a backdrop.

Check-in at Castello Dal Pozzo 5★, a restored aristocratic residence overlooking the water, ideal for setting the pace of the journey. Depending on arrival time, stroll in Arona or take in the view from the Rocca belvedere for a first look at the islands.

Day 2 – Sunday 13 June

Iles Borromées Golf Club

Morning golf high above Lake Maggiore: tree-lined fairways, subtle elevation changes, and postcard panoramas for an elegant, precise 18.

In the afternoon, discover Isola Bella (baroque palace, terraced gardens) then Isola dei Pescatori (lakeside lanes, pastel façades), with serene boat crossings between the islands.

Day 3 – Monday 14 June

Orta San Giulio — Piedmont's intimate gem

Head to Orta San Giulio: arcaded lanes, a waterside piazza, and a preserved, timeless feel. Boat across to Isola San Giulio for the Romanesque basilica and the "Way of Silence," where golden stone meets the lake's gentle hush. Return in the late afternoon for a quiet pause at the estate.

Day 4 – Tuesday 15 June

Varese Golf & transfer to Lake Como

Morning at Varese Golf Club: a grand, tree-lined park with classic routing, shaped tee shots, finely contoured greens, and the quiet nobility of a historic layout.

Afternoon at Sacro Monte di Varese (UNESCO): a hillside path of chapels with sweeping views over northern lakes.

Late day, arrival at Lake Como: a Y-shaped basin cradled by the Alps, pastel villages (Bellagio, Varenna), villas and terraced gardens (Balbianello, Carlotta), crystalline light, and ferry rhythms setting the lacustrine tempo.

Check-in at Albergo Lenno 4★, a waterfront charmer with Belle Époque façade, private jetty, pool, and serene bay-facing rooms.

Day 5 – Wednesday 16 June

Bellagio & Varenna • Villa Carlotta

Bellagio, the “pearl” of the lake: flowered stairways, silk ateliers, and Punta Spartivento with its three-arm panorama. Ferry to Varenna—waterfront lanes, pastel façades, timeless charm.

Afternoon at Villa Carlotta (Tremezzo): a 17th-century villa with neoclassical marbles and terraced gardens, where camellias and cedars overlook the lake’s mirror. A gentle, lakeside tempo between villages and boats.

Day 6 – Thursday 17 June

Menaggio & Cadenabbia • Villa Balbianello

Morning tee time at Menaggio & Cadenabbia (1907), a lakeside classic with a British-club spirit, offers rolling fairways, strategic angles, and quick greens with views of the Grigne and Bellagio. In the afternoon, discover Villa del Balbianello in Lenno with its iconic loggia, sculpted cypresses, and terraces above the water, one of Lake Como’s most cinematic landmarks.

Day 7 – Friday 18 June

Villa d'Este Golf & Brunate panorama

Morning golf on an Italian classic (1926): Golf Club Villa d'Este, a wooded parkland layout with precise lines, tightly framed fairways between chestnut trees, and subtly undulating greens, old-school elegance, pure swing pleasure.

In the afternoon, ascent to Brunate: majestic views over the Como basin and the Alps. Overnight at Hotel Promessi Sposi 4★, a contemporary lakeside address facing Lecco, with clean lines and bright rooms opening onto the water.

Day 8 – Saturday 19 June

Lecco & Lake Como's shores

Head to Lecco, the elegant southern gateway to Lake Como: a palm-lined lungolago, sunlit arcades, and mountain vistas mirrored on the water. Unhurried strolls at the lake's rhythm, browsing boutiques and enjoying a gelato on the piazza, then a wellness interlude at the hotel spa.

Late-afternoon waterfront walk as the light turns golden.

Day 9 – Sunday 20 June

Bergamo L'Albenza • Lake Iseo

Morning golf at Bergamo L'Albenza: 27 holes set in a wooded park, rolling fairways and demanding greens.

Afternoon in Città Alta: Renaissance piazzas and sweeping views from the Venetian walls.

Late day, head to Lake Iseo, the most discreet of the great lakes: a tranquil mirror between mountains and the Franciacorta vineyards, the silhouette of Monte Isola (the largest lake island in Europe), fishing hamlets, and golden light skimming the water.

Check-in at Hotel Rivalago 4★, a charming lakeside address with waterside terraces, a shorefront garden, and panoramic breakfast facing Monte Isola.

Day 10 – Monday 21 June

Franciacorta, the sparkling route

Head into the homeland of Italy's finest bubbles: immaculate vine rows, vaulted cellars, and guided tastings at two benchmark estates (Satèn, Rosé, elegant dosage profiles).

Afternoon nature break in the Torbiere del Sebino reserve: wooden boardwalks over still waters, reedbeds, and mirror-like lake reflections framed by vineyards and mountains.

Day 11 – Tuesday 22 June

Franciacorta Golf & transfer to Lake Garda

In the heart of the vineyards, Franciacorta unveils its 27 holes (Brut, Satèn, Rosé) threading between water features and groves, a classic parkland that rewards precise shot-making. Late afternoon, arrival on Lake Garda, Italy's largest: azure light, terraced olive groves, and elegant villages between Lombardy and Veneto. Day 12 – Wednesday 23 June

Verona & Valpolicella

Verona of the Scaligeri reveals Piazza delle Erbe, arcades polished by time, and a Roman amphitheatre glowing in the sun, an open-air opera set.

In the afternoon, explore Valpolicella at a benchmark estate: appassimento, barrels, and blending secrets unveil the soul of Amarone, Ripasso, and Recioto. Among cypresses and dry-stone walls, the tasting guides the palate through terroir nuances, from velvety tannins to lingering spice.

Return to the hotel to enjoy the serenity of the hills.

Day 13 – Thursday 24 June

Arzaga Golf Club & Garda crescendo

In the heart of the vineyards, Franciacorta offers 27 holes (Brut, Satèn, Rosé) weaving between water features and groves, a classic parkland rewarding precise shots.

Late afternoon brings arrival on Lake Garda, Italy's largest, with azure light, terraced olive groves, and elegant villages between Lombardy and Veneto. Enjoy an unhurried stroll in Bardolino or Lazise along cypress-lined quays, where citrus scents and ochre façades mirror in the water.
